

The Subcontractor Quality Plan – A Design and Roadmap (1.0 hours, 1.0-AIA HSW)



Having the subcontractor take responsibility for the quality of their work and coordination with other subcontractors that affect their work is critical for a successful project. The first step in taking ownership for quality is having a sound quality plan in place that is job specific and flexible to the needs of the project. Making sure that the quality program addresses the entire project scope of work and all work activates associated with the scope of work. We will go over what makes a good Subcontractor Quality Plan informative, benefits the project as whole, and gives clear direction to the project managers and tradesman.
