

Job Site Construction Observation (2.0 hours, 2.0-AIA HSW)



We will perform a job site observation of construction from the foundation to the roof and everything inbetween, going over several different construction materials and systems. Building construction can be complex and include many trades. Reviewing the construction during an on-site observation review can be daunting and confusing. The key to a good review is understanding the installation procedures for all the materials being installed, being able to identify the substrate acceptance, and knowing where the difficult installation conditions that need special attention are located for each system, including the transitions between products and systems.

- 2. Recognize proper installation requirements and be able to identify incorrect work in place.
- 3. Discuss best practices and understand what to look for during construction observation site reviews.
- 4. Produce a better set of Construction Documents by applying what you have learned about job site observation.
