Construction dust can lead to health-related illnesses for workers and future occupants of the building.









Best practices include:

- > Provide areas for dust producing activities such as sanding, sawing, cutting, etc. outside the building envelope and/or partitions between finished areas and dust producing activities.
- > Budget for regular site cleaning.
- > Store materials on raised platforms.
- > Regularly sweep construction dust off the floors using a sweeping compound that does not leave any residue that could prevent proper adhesion or application of materials.
- > Provide walk-off mats and/or boot scrapes between construction areas and finished spaces.
- > Remove accumulated water or spills as quickly as possible.
