

### Construction dust can lead to health-related illnesses for workers and future occupants of the building.



Use floor protection.



Use sweeping compound without oil or wax.



Construction debris on finished carpet.



Moisture in building after ductwork arrives.

#### Best practices include:

- > Provide areas for dust producing activities such as sanding, sawing, cutting, etc. outside the building envelope and/or partitions between finished areas and dust producing activities.
- > Budget for regular site cleaning.
- > Store materials on raised platforms.
- > Regularly sweep construction dust off the floors using a sweeping compound that does not leave any residue that could prevent proper adhesion or application of materials.
- > Provide walk-off mats and/or boot scrapes between construction areas and finished spaces.
- > Remove accumulated water or spills as quickly as possible.
