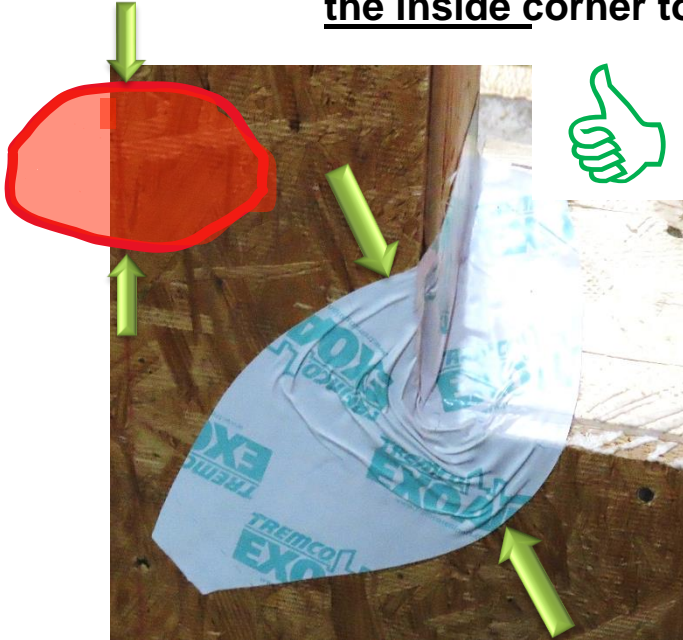




Window detailing with a peel and stick could be tricky at the inside corners and not all manufactures require special detailing.

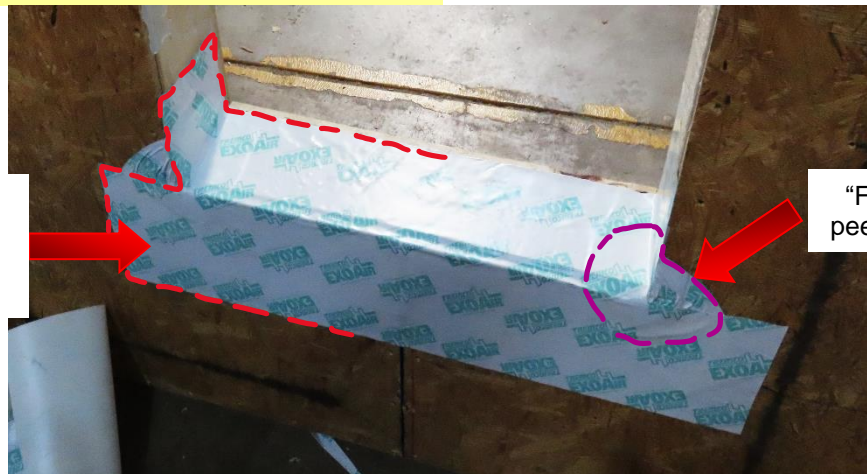
I recommend utilizing the “Football” or “Bow Tie” detail at the inside corners, making sure that the detail is installed first and is wide enough at the inside corner to give complete coverage.



I prefer the “Football” because the overall width at the inside corner is substantial. There will be a little wrinkling, but as long as the membrane is properly rolled, and do not extend to the edges, the detail works well.

The “Bow Tie” is thinner at the middle, which is where the coverage must happen for this detail to work successfully. It is easy for the installer to mistakenly make the middle too thin or stretch the membrane and therefore, the inside corner might not have proper coverage of the membrane.
